Day Trip to Vergina (Saturday, June 22)

Price: 100€

Vergina is best known as the site of ancient [Aigai](#) (Aiyáí, *Aigai*, [Latinized](#): *Aegae*), the first capital of [Macedon](#) and an excavation of world class. It was there when in 336 BC Philip II was assassinated in the theatre and [Alexander the Great](#) was proclaimed king. The ancient site was discovered in 1976 and excavated under the leadership of archaeologist [Manolis Andronikos](#). The excavation unearthed the burial sites of many kings of Macedon, including the tomb of [Philip II](#), father of [Alexander the Great](#), which, unlike so many other tombs, had not been disturbed or looted. It is also the site of an extensive royal palace. The archaeological museum of Vergina was built to house all the artifacts found at the site and is one of the most important museums in Greece.
